Dear Barbecue Participant,

Please find list of approved kosher symbols below. As per barbecue guidelines, only unopened products with one of the symbols below will be allowed into this years barbecue competition.

Special Note Regarding Beer

All **standard** domestic unflavored beers with no additives are acceptable, even without kosher certification. This applies to light, dark, and non-alcoholic beers. Beers produced at microbreweries, pub breweries, craft breweries, and flavored beer (including those flavored with spices, botanicals, or fruits) require kosher certification and therefore must have an acceptable kosher symbols. Please note: sweet stouts, cream stouts, milk stouts, and other beers which contain lactose are dairy and cannot be used for the barbecue **even with Kosher certification**. If you are uncertain about a particular beer, please feel free to speak to a Kollel rabbi.
